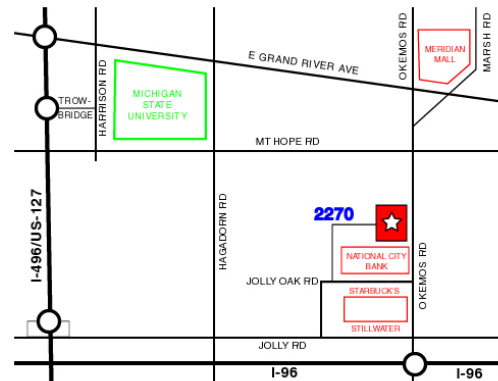

Bunion correction is one of our surgical specialties, as we are usually able to keep most patients walking without crutches and return them to their shoes within two weeks after the procedure.



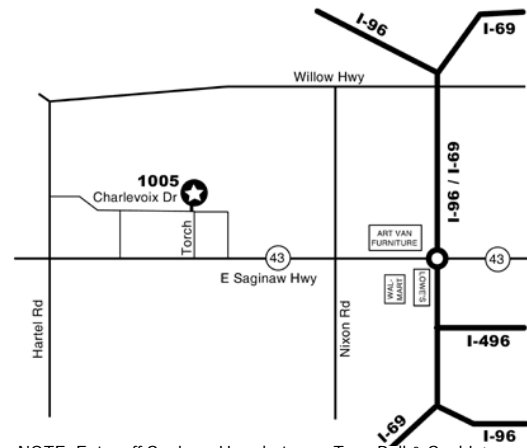
