Posterior Tibial Tendinitis - M76.821 , M76.822
Neuroma - G57.61 , G57.2

Procedure (CPT) Code: L3020 x 2 - Custom-molded orthotics (no brace attached)

These disorders are a result of an abnormal foot structure causing improper mechanics during gait. This results in excessive stress to the foot and ankle with long term effects possible leading to a chronic condition which may require surgical intervention.

Orthotic devices are recommended for these disorders in an attempt to correct the biomechanical imbalances resulting from the abnormal foot structure. These devices hold the foot and ankle in an anatomically correct position and help reduce stress to the foot and ankle. They are not attached to braces.

The cost of these devices is \$500.00 (per pair) which includes taking the impressions, fabrication, distribution, biomechanical exam and gait analysis.
